BRIEF COURSE DESCRIPTION

During the course, attention will be focused: 1) on the structures of the Italian language (phonetics, morpho-syntax, lexicon-semantics); b) on short conversations on topics concerning every day situations of life and italian culture. We will focus on oral expression (speaking), writing, oral comprehension (listening), and reading. The aims are: a) to make students learn basic grammar italian structures; b) to make students able to use the grammar rules in speech, in real communication.

- 5. Learning skills: the student will develop skills that will allow him to reuse the knowledge acquired in other study courses.
